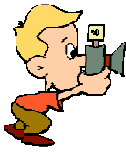
Dates: October 22, 2016 through March 25, 2017 (**deadline**).

How it works: Clubs complete as many **Photo Missions** as possible and submit photos by deadline. Each successfully completed Photo Mission earns points.

Include Club name, Photo Mission #, brief description, date taken.

Photo Missions: Take picture of Club members with:

1. EMS personnel
2. Statue or Historical monument in your town
3. Construction vehicle
4. Police Officer
5. Club photo with ALL members present
6. Modeling sunglasses AND hats
7. With family and friends
8. At your Town Hall
9. Dress like construction workers by a construction sign
10. Body of Water
11. Photo of your choice... anything goes!
12. Club picture WITH another club
13. In an elevator
14. BONUS 1: Provide proof that you advertised your photo(s) with a local media outlet (i.e. newspaper, FB, website)
15. BONUS 2: At a CJW Meeting



Rules:

1. Pictures must include at least 10% of total club members.
2. Each club can only turn in 15 photos.
3. No combining Missions into one photo (i.e modeling sunglasses and hats (#6) at your town hall #8).
4. Be respectful in everything you do.
5. Obey the law! (if you choose otherwise, we are not bailing you out, but would love to hear the story!)
6. Get creative and have fun!

Awards: (presented at Spring Conference, anticipated May 6, 2017)

- Grand Prize: Club will be presented with items to donate to local charity of choice (possible items such as bikes, Legos, etc).
- Club Participation
- Missions Completed
- Creativity

Judging Criteria:

- # of Photo Missions Completed (point value of 1 for each photo mission)
- Creativity (for each photo mission: scale of 1-3; 1=no creativity; 2=some; 3=very creative)
- Completed and submitted by deadline (point value of 1 for each photo mission)
- 1st Club in with criteria met = extra points
